

CORONA VIRUS UPDATE



In light of the Coronavirus cases in South Africa - and the address by the President of the Republic of South Africa highlighting measures put in place to contain the spread of the virus, Lanseria International Airport would like to inform all travellers that the airport has taken extra measures in its bid to assist in this fight.



HYGIENE

Hand sanitisers are being placed in areas where there is high foot traffic for all to sanitize their hands.

Communique on basic hygiene has been distributed in all areas of the airport for all to read and familiarize themselves.

We have, through our cleaning company, changed our cleaning schedules to ensure high touch areas and high-risk areas are covered.

We have also increased the frequency of deep cleaning our facilities.



CHECK-IN

All staff members have been trained on how to handle any Coronavirus case.

All passengers are being encouraged to check-in online.

At check-in and at boarding, please present your paperwork i.e. identity document and ticket, the check in agent or boarding agent will read it whilst you are holding it, they will not touch it.

Passengers will also be requested by the check-in agents to confirm if they have travelled outside of the country in the last 14 days (especially from the high-risk areas). All health protocols will be observed should this be the case (e.g. screening by the ports health authorities).

The airport is also investigating other measures to contain the spread of the virus. These include, but is not limited to manning of the airport's main entrances with personnel to ensure that all persons entering our terminal building clean their hands using the hand spray or hand rub provided.

We would like to encourage all passengers to take their own precautionary measures they deem fit. The airport is fully operational and will advise of any changes. For flight updates kindly contact your airline.
